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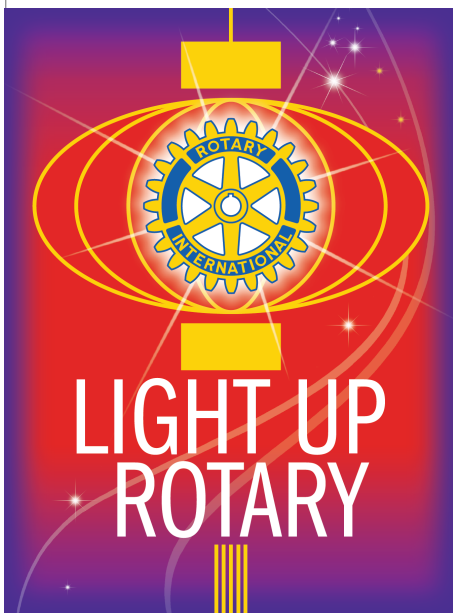

Last weekend I found a home for the last bag of grapefruit and would like to say a huge Thank You to all the Rotarians and Rotariannes who rallied around at very short notice to empty the crates so we could remove them from Rotary House in time for the two functions being held there that weekend. It was a wonderful example of Rotary in action.

Sincere thanks must go to Maureen for organising for the 5 crates to come to Taupo. The crates are put in Napier service stations for people to contribute any excess fruit they have which the Rotary Clubs then distribute around both Islands and have been doing this for 20 years.

Contact was made with all the local rest homes and organisations which do such good works in our community – Age Concern Hospice Food Bank Plunket Women's' Refuge St Vincent de Paul Salvation Army Inspire Church – and they all came and collected as much fruit as they felt they would be able to use.

Phillipa promoted the fruit on the Rotary Facebook and Website as well as arranging for mention to be made on the Community Notice Boards of the local Radio Stations which resulted in early arrivals.

With our planned "Monster" Garage Sale and Auction on Saturday 27th September, some members and Rotariannes have dusted off their preserving pans and made Lemon Cheese and Grapefruit marmalade to be sold on a produce table. We are really grateful to John de Lautour for obtaining a 25 Kilo bag of sugar at a very discounted rate from Bin Inn which has helped enormously in the success of this project.

We still have some sugar left so now we are seeking home made cakes, biscuits, cup cakes or scones etc to add to our produce table. If you are able to make something for us, it would be greatly appreciated. Contact me if you would like some sugar and eggs.
